Higher Education Faculty Staffing in the New York Hudson Valley: By the Numbers

Professors in the Hudson Valley:

- 8,846 total faculty¹
 - 2,758 tenured or on tenure-track (31%)
 - 6,088 have no tenure available, Contingent Faculty (69%)
 - 4,961 part time no tenure, Adjunct Faculty (56%)
- Student enrollment: 109,243²
 - Students paid an estimated \$1,633,269,961 in tuition, fees, room and board to Hudson Valley Schools in the 2011-12 school year³
- 28 total Colleges and Universities⁴⁵

Professors on campuses without any faculty union present:

- 4,531 total faculty⁶
 - 1,283 tenured or on tenure-track (28% of faculty)
 - 3,258 have no tenure available, Contingent Faculty (72% of faculty)
 - 2,316 part time no tenure, Adjunct Faculty (51% of faculty)
- Student enrollment at schools with no faculty union present: 46,991⁷

- Average net price student pay at schools without faculty unions: \$23,725⁸⁹
- Average net price student pay at schools with faculty unions: \$9,052 (\$17,945 at four year schools)¹⁰

- Of 20¹¹ private schools (19 independent non-profit and 1 proprietary), only two are represented by faculty unions (Bard College¹² and Manhattanville College¹³)
 - Schools without faculty unions are:
 - Cochran School of Nursing; 24 *contingent*, 0 *tenured/track*
 - College of New Rochelle; 447 *contingent*, 84 *tenured/track*
 - Concordia College; 120 *contingent*, 1 *tenured/track*
 - Culinary Institute of America; 184 *contingent*, 0 *tenured/track*
 - Dominican College of Blauvelt; 194 *contingent*, 48 *tenured/track*
 - Iona College; 22 *contingent*, 170 *tenured/track*
 - Marist College; 420 *contingent*, 162 *tenured/track*
 - Mercy College; 745 *contingent*, 94 *tenured/track*
 - Mount Saint Mary College; 189 *contingent*, 91 *tenured/track*
 - New York Medical College; 370 *contingent*, 68 *tenure/track*
 - Nyack College; 210 *contingent*, 124 *tenured/track*
 - Sarah Lawrence College; 153 *contingent*, 129 *tenured/track*
 - St. Joseph's Seminary and College; 30 *contingent*, 0 *tenured/track*
 - St. Thomas Aquinas College; 7 *contingent*, 60 *tenured/track*
 - St. Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary; 11 *contingent*, 7 *tenured/track*
 - The College of Westchester¹⁴; 41 *contingent*, 0 *tenured/track*
 - Unification Theological Seminary; 3 *contingent*, 0 *tenured/track*
 - Vassar College; 88 *contingent*, 235 *tenured/track*¹⁵

- Of 8 public college, all 8 have a faculty union present¹⁶
 - Public colleges with faculty unions are: Dutchess Community College, Orange County Community College, Rockland Community College, State University College at New Paltz, State University College at Purchase, Sullivan County Community College, Ulster County Community College, Westchester Community College¹⁷
